

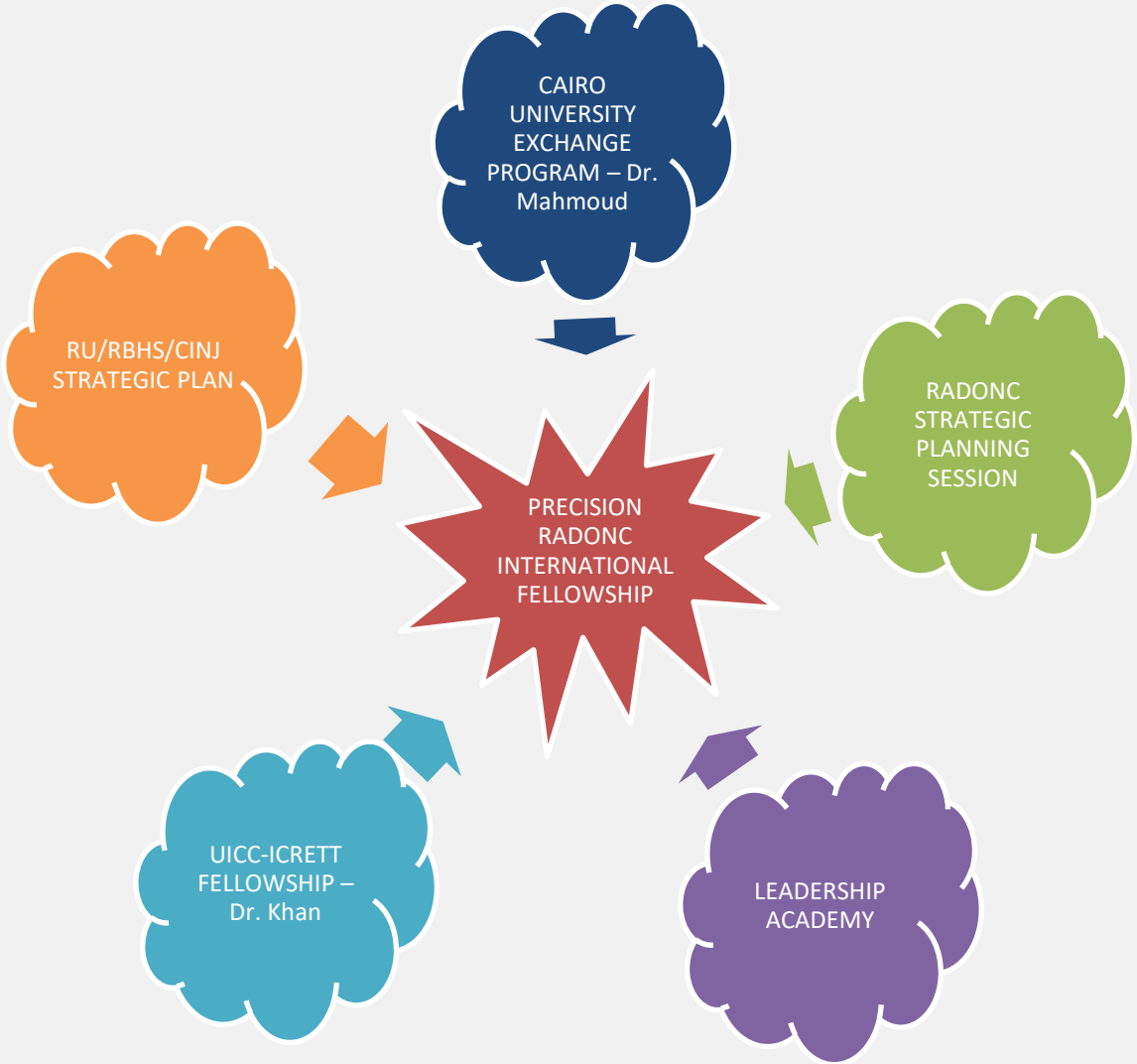

- develop a model that can be replicated globally

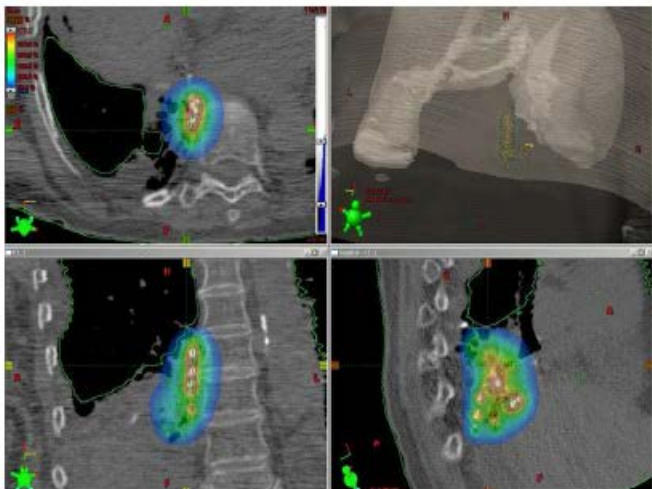
