

Holistic Advising 2.0: Evaluating Post-Pandemic Advising Impact

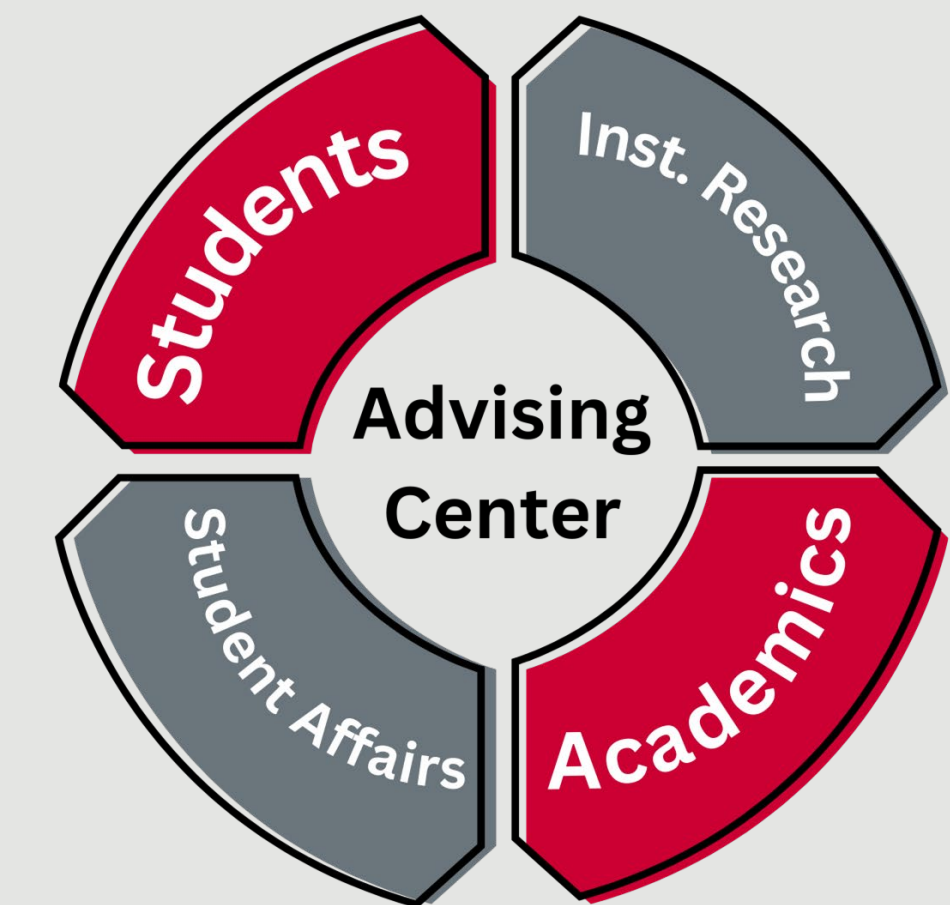
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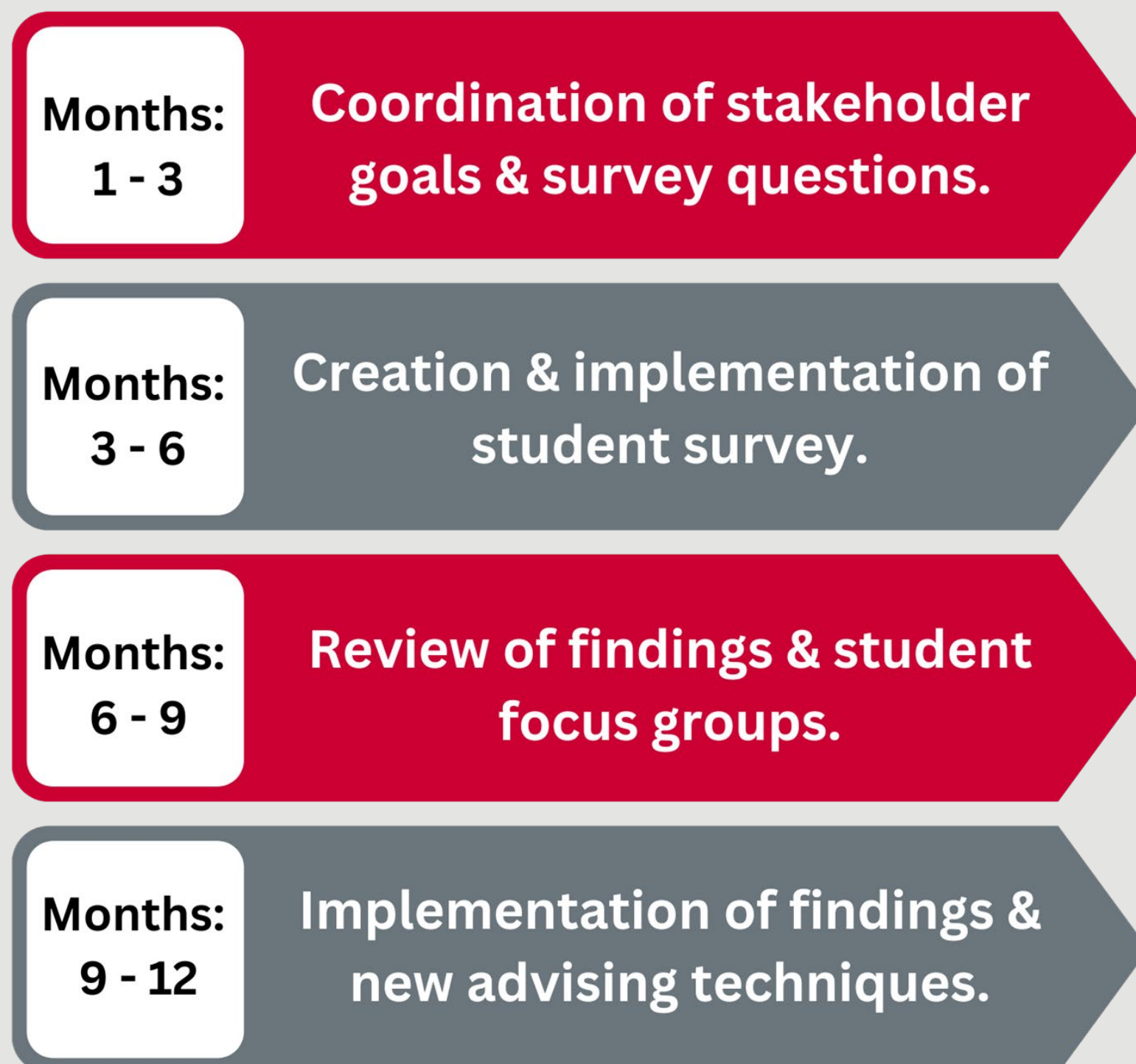
Abstract:

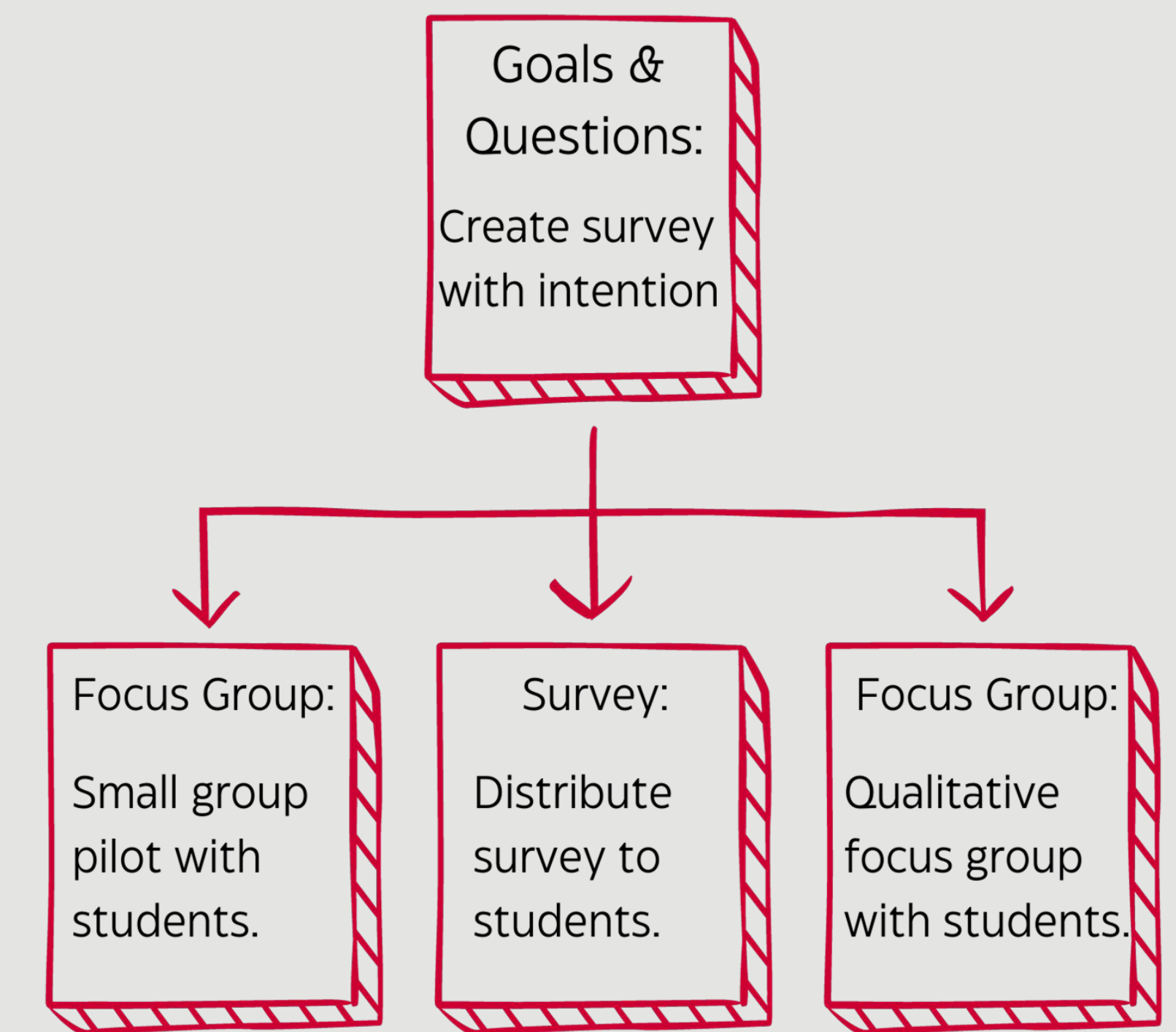
